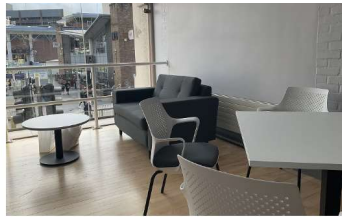

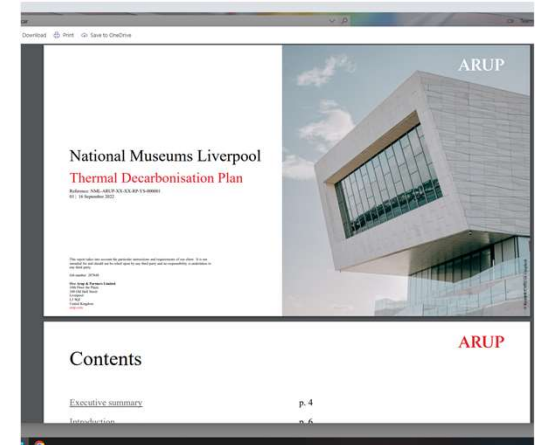

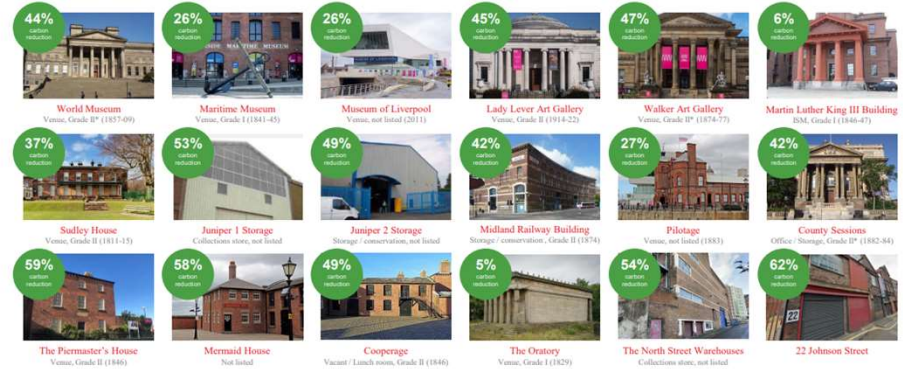

## Summary of interventions

### Carbon savings compared with building's baseline emissions

The World Museum and Museum of Liverpool contribute to over 50% of the total carbon emissions for the estate. As such, the carbon savings for any interventions applied to other buildings can look overshadowed.
